- To foster a culture of respect, empathy, and understanding



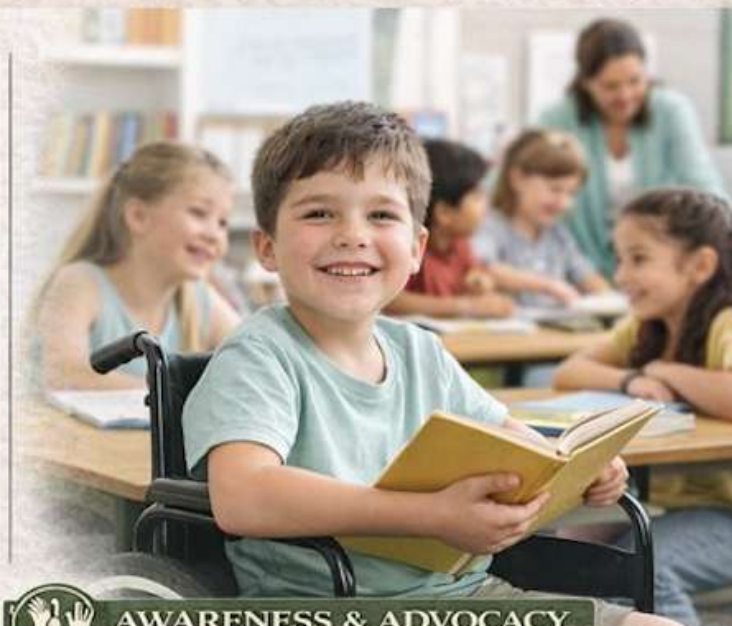
